

AGENDA: Discussing the cross border implication of The Ethiopia - Tigaray conflict

The Security Council, the United Nations' principal crisis-management body, is empowered to impose binding obligations on the 193 UN member states to maintain peace. The Security Council's five permanent and ten elected members meet regularly to assess threats to international security, including civil wars, natural disasters, arms proliferation, and terrorism. As we convene in this respected gathering, we must address the existence of a threat to the peace or act of aggression and promote and protect human rights in discharging its responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and security.

In this session, our focus is on "Discussing the cross border implication of The Ethiopia - Tigaray conflict". The members of the Security Council strongly urged for cooperation with and support to the African Union High Representative.

The members of the Security Council reaffirmed their strong commitment to the sovereignty, political independence, territorial integrity and unity of Ethiopia.

Reflecting on the aftermath of the First Gulf War in the early 1990s, one can't help but envision the heart-wrenching scenes of families torn apart, homes shattered, and communities struggling to rebuild amidst the ruins of war. The sanctions imposed and the rigorous inspections that followed only added to the hardships faced by the resilient people of Iraq, testing their resolve and resilience in the face of adversity. As the world hurtled towards a new era, tensions escalated, casting a shadow of uncertainty over the daily lives of ordinary Iraqis. Accusations and suspicions loomed large, creating a climate of fear and apprehension as the specter of conflict loomed ever closer.
